### INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE AUTHORS

One author, as the first author, can submit no more than two papers. Maximum length of papers is 6 pages (with enclosures) format A4, all margins 2.5 cm. The papers should be prepared in MS Word for Windows format; font: Times New Roman (Multilanguage support); single spacing.

A paper should include the following parts: title, full names of the authors, abstract and the keywords, introduction, paragraphs (material and methods of work, results and discussion of the results), conclusion and a list of references.

Posters should be sized 70 x 100 cm.
